

Year 1 List of Learning Ideas

Maths

- Counting **forwards and backwards** in steps of 1's, 2's, 5's and 10's from any number. This is a vital skill throughout not only the infacts, but also the whole of your child's schooling life.
- Practising Times tables 2x, 3x, 5x, 10x – Use TT rockstars to help.
- Cooking and baking – estimating and measuring accurately.
- Estimating how many sweets are in the bag. Then checking as you eat them!
- Using a tally chart to tally how many rainbows or bears you see in windows as you walk past on your daily walk. Then you can turn it into a pictogram.
- Measuring objects around the house accurately using a ruler. If not a ruler, measure in length using any items you have.
- Learning how to tell the time. O'clock, quarter past, half past and quarter to.
- Learn to recognise all coins and notes. Begin to add coins together and understand which coins don't exist.

English

- Reading for at least 15 minutes a day – this can be independent or sharing stories with family.
- Read anything! Road signs, instructions, letters.
- Ask and answer questions about what you have read. What words were you unsure of? Can you find out what they mean? Can you predict what will happen next?
- Writing regularly – keep a daily diary or scrap book of all the amazing learning and exploring that you have been doing.
- Write letters to loved ones – especially if you are missing Grandparents and friends.

Fun ideas

- Play the alphabet game. Write the alphabet down the side of a piece of paper and then choose any subject and see if you can find a word linked to that subject which starts with every letter of the alphabet.
- Play any board game with your family.
- Paint pebbles with different designs. You could use inspirational words or maybe paint some of the 'Draw With Rob' characters that we have been practising.
- Draw around yours and your households hand and create a picture with them all. Label it 'Lockdown Hands 2020'

- Log onto BBC bitesize and see what fun activities they have.
- Get active with Joe Wickes PE lessons every day at 9am.
