What is the Sports Premium?

The PE and sports premium are designed to help primary schools improve the quality of the PE and sport activities they offer their pupils. The funding is jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport; it comes directly to primary schools to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children. The funding can only be spent on sport and PE provision in schools.

P.E. and Sport Premium Funding Report – Summer 2022

For the academic year September 2021 to July 2022 the school will receive £19140 in Sport Premium Funding plus £ 11,862.18, which was carried forward from the previous year. This gave us a total of £31,002.18. Of this we have spent £30,405.29.

We must use the funding to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of Physical Education, Sport and Physical Activity (PESPA) on offer to pupils at Wilnecote Junior Academy.

This means we will use the premium to:

- 1. To develop or add to the PeSSPA already in place in school (referring to the aims below)
- 2. To make improvements now for future pupils

The 5 key indicators where improvements should be seen are:

- 1. The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity, aiming for 30 minutes a day within school time.
- 2. The profile of PE and sport is raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement.

- 3. Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport.
- 4. Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils.
- 5. Increased participation in competitive sport.

The National Curriculum aims are for all children:

• To be physically active, working towards a target of 30 minutes activity during and after the school day (excluding general play

times)

- To excel in a broad range of activities
- To engage in competition
- To lead healthy lifestyles

We aim to do meet the curriculum expectations with the help of the Sport Premium Funding by providing:

- A more inclusive curriculum
- A growth in traditional and alternative sports
- Improvements in our partnership work with other schools
- Creating links with other subjects that contribute to pupils' overall achievement and their greater social, spiritual, moral and cultural skills

Key achievements in academic Year 2021-2022:

Achieved the School Games Gold Sports Mark

Took part in over 15 competitions across Tamworth, where we were very successful in.

Won a range of competitions against other schools including the following:

- Y3 boys' Cross-Country
- Y5 boys' and girls' Cross-Country
- Y6 girls' Cross-Country
- Y5/6 Cricket

Ran an inclusive sports day, which had great feedback from staff, children and parents.

Provided a 'Sport 4 All' after school club which encouraged children with SEND to take part in new activities, which built their confidence. This saw these children take part in a competition against other schools.

Lunch time activities were ran by 'Sports Leaders' from year 5/6, this encouraged children to try new sports and stay active during their breaks. There is a range of activities, including the pump track and climbing.

Pupil Premium pupils were able to attend after school sports.

Areas for further improvement:

Develop Orienteering skills of teachers within school and the amount of OAA taught within the curriculum (cross-curricula)

Develop the PSHE link with PE and ensure the key skills for both are being taught.

Develop activities to be a fully established 'active school'.

Enhance the opportunities for our less active and other targeted groups.

Enable every year group to have the expertise of a coach.

Children to share good practice with other year groups.

Continue to:

Provide opportunities for 'Personal Challenge' within PE lessons and competitions

Increase the opportunities for children to lead during PE lessons

Provide opportunities for non-traditional sports and inspirational sessions for all
