



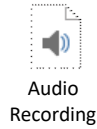

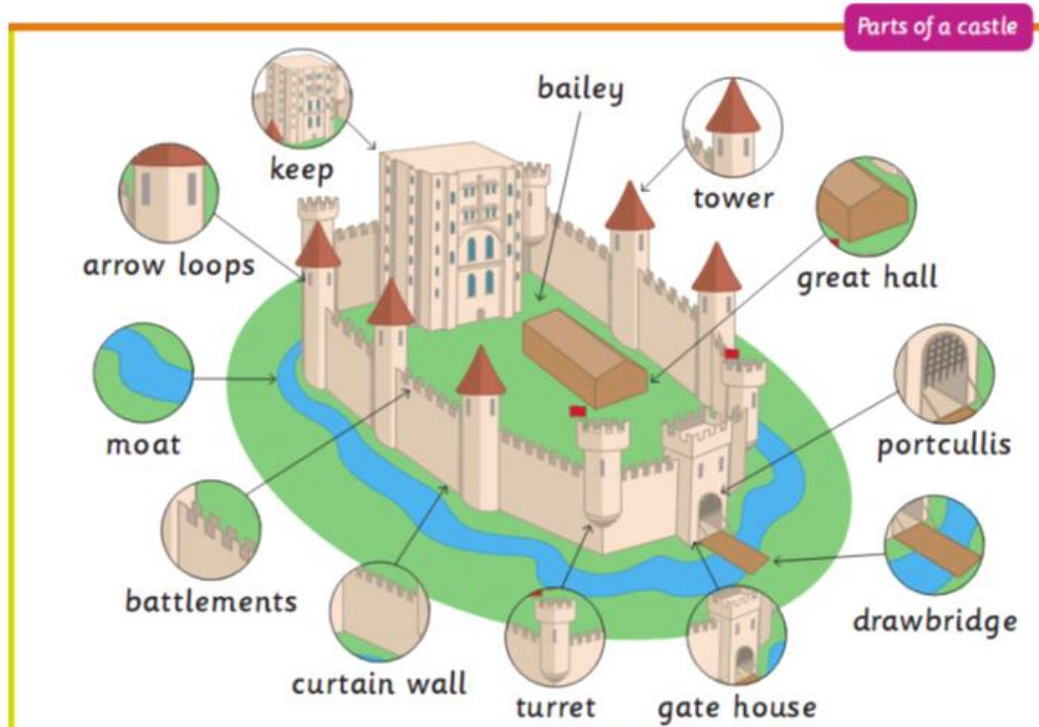

Keep - Large towers.

Drawbridge - A wooden bridge that can be raised or lowered.

Moat - Deep ditch filled with water

Battlements - Rectangular cut outs in a wall.

Curtain wall - Outer wall for extra protection.

Arrow loop - Narrow slits to launch arrows.

Portcullis - A heavy grilled door to protect the castle.
