Gold and red.

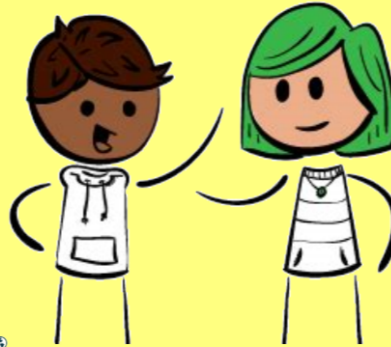
Quicker, slower,
